Federal Disaster Declaration Fact Sheet

September 13, 2010

On August 19, 2010, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Illinois, triggering the release of Federal funds to help individuals and communities recover from the Severe Storms and Flooding which occurred July 19 through August 7, 2010. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-1935-DR

Incident: Severe Storms and Flooding

Incident Period: July 19 through August 7, 2010

Federal Coordinating Officer: Gregory W. Eaton
National FCO Program

Individual Assistance: INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE
(Assistance to individuals and households):

Designated Counties: Carroll, Cook, DuPage, Jo Daviess,
Ogle, Stephenson, and Winnebago
Counties.

Public Assistance: PUBLIC ASSISTANCE
(Assistance to State and local governments and certain private nonprofit organizations for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

Designated Counties: Adams, Carroll, Jo Daviess, Ogle, Pike, Schuyler, and Stephenson Counties.

Hazard Mitigation: HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM
(Assistance to State and local governments and certain private non-profit organizations for actions taken to prevent or reduce long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

Designated Counties: All counties in the State of Illinois are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date after further evaluation.
